Student Right to Know – Equity in Athletics

Mayville State has documented calculation rates of students who participate in intercollegiate athletes and determined the financial support provided to male and female teams for operating expenses and athletically related aid. The most recent report is summarized below for the 2008-09 school year. In the Fall of 2008 there were 220 full time male and 229 full time female students enrolled at MSU. The average institutional coaching salaries of head coaches for male sports was \$ 20,440 while head coaches of female sports averaged \$ 16,222. It is important to note that all head coaches had other duties at the institution. Therefore, average annual salaries per Full Time Equivalent (FTE) coach were \$38,696 for male sports and \$31,356 for female sports. Average coaching salaries of part time assistant coaches was \$ 7,191 for men's sports and \$ \$3,700 for women's sports, while FTE salaries were \$20,135 for the men's teams and \$14,800 for women's teams.
