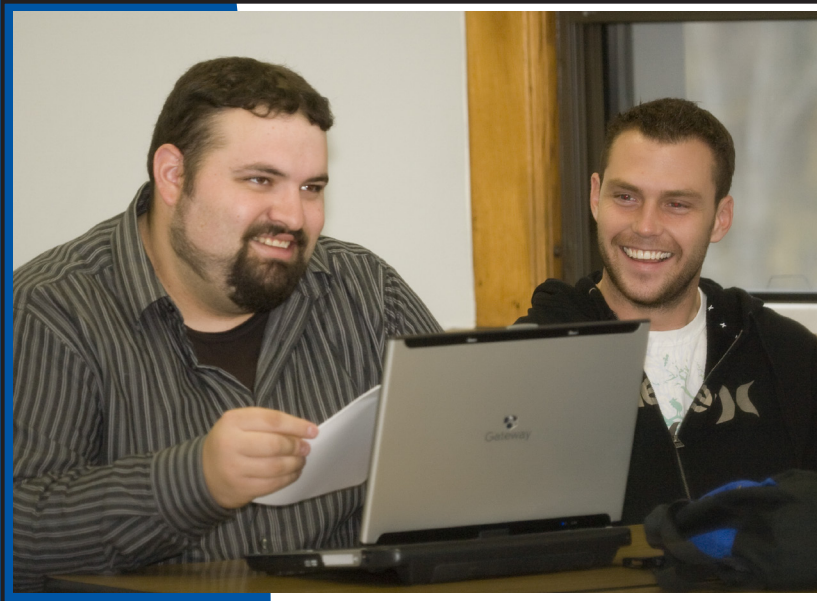

Social Science - Bachelor of Arts

Students pursuing this program must complete 32 semester hours of prescribed courses and twelve hours of electives, for a total of 44 hours. Students will also be required to complete at least one minor. Social Science majors complete 36 hours of general education including COMM 110, ECON 105, ENGL 110, ENGL 120, GEOG 103, MATH 103 and SOC 110, which are pre-requisite courses to this major.

Composite in Social Science Education Bachelor of Science in Education

Students pursuing the Social Science Composite Degree (44 semester hours) must meet the following criteria:

- Take the core requirements plus two specializations
- Majors can qualify for additional teaching areas in Sociology or Psychology by taking 6 hours in those areas.
- Students will also take the education courses for secondary education as outlined in the Education section of the catalog, including EDUC 485-Secondary Methods for Social Science.

Social Science Composite majors complete 36 hours of general education courses, including COMM 110, ENGL 110, ENGL 120, GEOG 103, MATH 103, PSYC 111 and SOC 110, which are pre-requisite courses to this major.
