



## 2010-11 Non-Resident Merit Scholarships and other Academic Scholarships for High School and Transfer students from Montana, South Dakota, Manitoba, Saskatchewan, Kansas, Nebraska, Michigan, & Missouri

Awards are based on a combination of ACT/SAT scores and high school or college GPA. In order to be considered for Non Resident Merit scholarships, students should submit an Application for Admission and ACT/SAT scores and High School or college transcripts. No other scholarship application is necessary. Any student receiving the Non Resident Merit Scholarship must be enrolled full time and will be considered for a renewal after their first year of enrollment based on their institutional GPA. Students with a 2.50-2.99 GPA will be eligible for a half scholarship, while students with 3.00-4.00 GPA will be eligible for a full scholarship.

**Honor and Leadership Scholarships:** Students from these states/provinces may be considered for \$1000 Honor scholarships in combination with the Non Resident Merit award if they have a cumulative high school GPA of at least 3.50 and an ACT of 25+ (or SAT of 1680+).

**Presidential Mentorships:** Awarded to select freshmen. These scholarships are renewable for additional years, dependent upon a cumulative grade point average of 3.50 and can be awarded in conjunction with the Non Resident Merit award.

In addition to the academic scholarships listed above, new students may qualify for scholarships provided by the MSU Foundation. New students who complete a scholarship application ([www.mayvillestate.edu/cost/scholarships.cfm](http://www.mayvillestate.edu/cost/scholarships.cfm)) will be considered for any MSU Foundation Scholarship if they meet the specific award criteria.

Participation scholarships for music and theater are also available for new students and are awarded based on participation in those respective extra curricular activities. Dollars for Scholars awards are frequently awarded from students' local communities and students should contact their local high school. Mayville State may match a Dollars for Scholars award received during the student's initial year of enrollment by awarding a renewal scholarship in their second year to a maximum of \$250.
