



INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ESTIMATED BUDGET

DESCRIPTION OF FEES

TUITION:

Cost of 24 semester-hour credits (12-18 credits per semester.)

FEES:

Fees include student activity fees, notebook (laptop) computer fees, and also technology/maintenance fee. The computers remain the property of Mayville State University, but are offered for purchase at end of the lease agreement with manufacturer. To learn more about the computers, log on to our web site at www.mayvillestate.edu. *Not included in estimate: first-year students are charged \$35.00 for orientation activities and a student identification card.

LIVING EXPENSES:

ROOM: Room rates are based on a double room in either a suite or regular room; and rates will range from \$1676/year to \$2650/year. Included in the fees are cable television and 24/7 direct internet service. A non-refundable room reservation fee of \$50.00 is required each year to reserve a room and will be deducted from your fall semester room fee when you enroll.

BOARD: The board plan costs are for 14 meals/7 days in the main cafeteria; you may eat any fourteen meals at any meal time during a seven day period. Other meal plans are available. Meals NOT used during each week are lost.

OTHER:

BOOKS, SUPPLIES & MISCELLANEOUS: Books and supplies may be purchased at the MSU Bookstore or wherever the student chooses. After registration for classes each semester, student may request permission to charge books one week prior to the start of each semester until fee payment day, approximately ten days after classes begin. Books and supplies estimate is \$900. Miscellaneous costs of \$2,800 may include, but are not limited to, local and USA transportation, entertainment and recreation, personal care, emergency and other miscellaneous costs. **The cost of travel from the home country to Mayville and back is NOT included in the estimate. Students certify that round-trip travel to North Dakota is prepaid. *** Students who plan to remain in the United States during June, July, and August must provide an additional \$2250.00 for living expenses.

HEALTH INSURANCE: North Dakota State Board of Higher Education policy requires all international students to have health and accident insurance from the time of their registration until completion of studies. The cost for our International Student health insurance is approximately \$894 per year for a single student which is subject to change. Rates are also available for a student's spouse or for entire family-see enclosed International Student Health Insurance information. Canadian students must provide proof of health and medical insurance coverage. ****Health insurance must be paid or proven prior to the start of classes during an enrolled semester.*** Credit card payments are accepted by contacting our Business Office at 701-788-4757.
