Bachelor of University Studies Online Degree

The bachelor of university studies (B.U.S.) online degree program is intended for transfer students who have completed previous coursework at a two-or four-year college or university. The B.U.S. degree provides flexibility for students who wish to determine the content of their degree rather than pursue a specific major. Each student will design a program leading to specific educational goals, but not necessarily within any one department. This provides a flexible and adaptable degree based on your individual needs and previously completed coursework.

The Program

This flexible degree is available to students who wish to structure their own program of study while selecting classes that are valuable for their personal goals. This degree could be the right fit for you if you are not sure which program of study you prefer.

The online B.U.S. program allows you to draw from a number of different online coursework options; including business; early childhood; education; mathematics; library media and information science; and health, physical education, and recreation. Students should note that the B.U.S. degree does not qualify the graduate for teacher certification.

Students who previously attended college and did not earn a degree for whatever reason will find this program allows them to return and complete their education. The bachelor of university studies program at MSU is very transfer-friendly.

Any coursework previously earned from regionally accredited institutions will be accepted and applied to the B.U.S. core requirements, general education, optional minor, and electives as appropriate, regardless of the academic program in which the student was previously enrolled.

Upper Division (300-400 level) Core Requirements - 36 upper division semester hours

General Education - 36 semester hours

Optional Minor - 16-21 semester hours

Instructional Technology Certificate Courses - 5 semester hours

Concepts of Fitness & Wellness/First Aid & CPR - 3 semester hours

Electives as needed to total 120 semester hours and meet the Mayville State residency requirement

Total for B.U.S. degree - 120 semester hours required

Other requirements:

- · 30 semester hours in residency with Mayville State University
- Minimum of 2.0 GPA in general education, major, optional minor, and Mayville State courses
- Nine (9) semester hours of upper division core requirements must be completed with Mayville State University
- Six (6) semester hours of optional minor requirements must be completed with Mayville State University
- 36 hours of 300 to 400-level courses and 36 hours from a 4-year institution
