Required credits to graduate with this degree: 120

Students pursuing this program complete core requirements and two areas of specialization. Depending upon the choice of specializations, 22 to 28 hours are in prescribed courses and 18 to 24 hours are electives, for a total of 46 hours. Students are required to complete at least one minor.

Social Science majors must complete 36 hours of Essential Studies. The following Essential Studies courses are required: COMM 110, ENGL 110, ENGL 120 or ENGL 125, GEOG 103, MATH 103, PSYC 111, and SOC 110. These courses are pre-requisite courses for this major.
