## Summary of Graduates' Status, Commencement Day, May 2013

(Career Services asks graduates participating in commencement to fill out a data card)

This data is based on the 'survey' cards of **69 participants** ... graduates of Fall 2012, Spring 2013, and Summer 2013. (76 completed the card but the data from 1 summer 2012 and 6 fall 2013 grads was not included in this summary.)

25 of those grads indicated they had already secured a job (36%...same as last year), but not all provided the job details. Those indicating jobs at this time included:

- 10 of 18 Fall 2012 grads (55% with jobs)
- 12 of 40 Spring 2013 grads (30% with jobs)
- 3 of 11 Summer 2013 grads (27% with jobs)

Grads were also asked about their post-graduation plans. 7 options were listed, and grads could choose more than one option. *Upon graduation, I immediately plan to:* 

1.	Find a Job	30 <b>(43%)</b>
2.	Start working	30 <b>(43%)</b>
3.	Raise a Family	7 <b>(10%)</b>
4.	Continue More Undergraduate Study	3 <b>(4%)</b>
5.	Enter Graduate School	15 <b>(21%)</b>
6.	Join the Military	0
7.	Do Volunteer Service	4 (6%)
