*Bachelor of Science in Education - Combination Online/Mayville Evening*



The BS Ed in Elementary Education degree will prepare students to teach in grades 1 through 6. The evening option on the Mayville State University campus is offered as a combination of online and interactive video network courses on the Mayville State campus. The Mayville State campus is easily accessible and located less than an hour drive from Grand Forks or Fargo. Remain near home, work, and family while completing classes toward a four-year degree that will open doors to exciting career opportunities. Mayville State's BS Ed Elementary Education program offers a unique opportunity for working adults in eastern North Dakota to pursue degree options in elementary education.

Note: Some courses require distance students to be available for daytime hours to complete arranged, in-school practicum experience hours.

MSU's Bachelor of Science degree in Elementary Education consists of courses in essential studies and institutional requirements, the major, and a required minor or second major. (Unless the student already has a bachelor's degree.)

Current Mayville State students who wish to apply for a kindergarten endorsement through ESPB must complete the Early Childhood Education minor and enroll in five (5) S.H. of kindergarten student teaching. Check the MSU Catalog for requirements of all minors and areas of specific teaching interest.
