Associate of Arts Degree

An Associate of Arts degree in business management is designed for students who wish to transfer to a fouryear program and develop a marketable skill within an abbreviated period of time. Upon completion of the twoyear degree, students will have completed the essential studies requirement of a four-year degree. All classes will transfer to a baccalaureate program at Mayville State University. A minimum of 62 semester hours is required for the two year degree.

The online A.A. degree in business management coursework is offered over a rotation schedule with the start-up cycle being offered in the fall, spring, or summer semesters for new enrollees.
