Purpose of the Nelson Family Endowed Scholarship

The purpose of the Nelson Family Endowed Scholarship is to help non-traditional students achieve their goals. The assistance is especially geared toward those individuals who may be changing their paths in life or those pursuing changes in careers. A special emphasis of the scholarship is to promote the concept of volunteerism, leadership development, and out-of-classroom experiences for the scholarship recipients.

Scholarship Eligibility

Awardees will be non-traditional aged students, 25 years of age or older.

This scholarship is renewable to students who maintain a 2.0 grade point average or greater. With each term, there is an expectation of improvement.

The eligible student must demonstrate a need for funds as evidenced by information submitted through the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

The scholarship recipients will work with the director of career services and internships to find volunteer opportunities with community groups, organizations, or departments on campus that suit their future goals. Recipients will be asked to report on their volunteer experiences.

The scholarship may be awarded to those in pursuit of associate's or bachelor's degrees. Students who have achieved the associate's degree are encouraged to apply for assistance in pursuing a bachelor's degree.

Those who participate in a varsity sport are not eligible for the scholarship.

Preference will be given to females, but both males and females will be considered.

The scholarship recipients must be full time, degree-seeking (associate's or bachelor's level) students who are pursuing the majority of their courses in residence at the Mayville State campus.

Application deadline is February 15 of each year.

Financial Aid

Federal programs through which aid is available form the basic core of assistance for most students. When students apply for aid from the federal programs, they must complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form to determine eligibility for financial assistance.

The FAFSA form is available on the Web at www.fafsa.ed.gov. Normally, to be considered for assistance in the fall semester, the completed FAFSA should be submitted for processing as soon as possible after January 1 of the year in which an applicant plans to enroll.

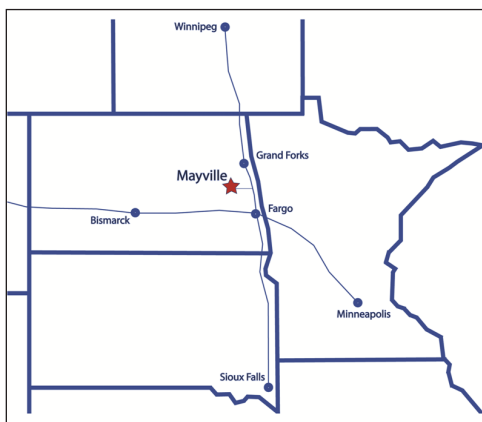
Visit Campus

Purpose of the Nelson Family Endowed Scholarship:

The purpose of this scholarship is to help non-traditional students achieve their goals. It is especially intended for those individuals who may be changing their path in life or those pursuing a change in careers. A special emphasis of the scholarship is to promote the concept of volunteerism, leadership development and out of classroom experiences for the recipients of these awards.

Initial Eligibility:

1. Applicants must be 25 years of age or older.
2. Initial academic qualifications include a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.00 or higher. In order for the scholarship to be renewed, the student must demonstrate improvement in their academic performance.
3. Applicants must demonstrate financial need as evidenced by information submitted through their FAFSA.
4. Applicants must be full time, degree seeking (Associate or Bachelor's level) students who are pursuing the majority of their courses in residence at the Mayville State campus.
5. Preference in awards will be given to female applicants, but both males and females will be considered.
6. Recipients will be expected to demonstrate their involvement in volunteer or service learning experiences, as well as in internship or out of class experiences.
7. A special application form must be submitted by February 15 in order to be considered for this scholarship. This application will include basic student data and a short essay completed by the applicant to demonstrate their need for financial assistance and their past and planned involvement in volunteer and service learning experiences.
8. The amount of initial scholarship awards will vary depending upon the recipient's needs but generally would not exceed \$7,500 per year.

Eligibility for Renewal:

1. Recipients of the scholarship who wish to be considered for a renewal must apply each year by February 15, using the special application form.
2. Academic performance of past recipients will be considered when making renewal decisions.
3. Past recipients must provide documentation of their involvement in campus or community based volunteer or service learning activities. Recipients are encouraged to enroll in structured service learning courses, internships, leadership development or other formal methods of documenting these out of class accomplishments.
4. Amounts of renewal scholarships may vary from original awards depending upon the unique situation of the student that may vary from year to year. Renewals of scholarships may extend until the completion of a bachelor's degree, but generally would not be awarded for more than five to six years.
