(approved for Humanities Essential Studies Credit)

UNIV 306: International Perspectives in Health II: 2 credit study abroad course

Study abroad course includes a 2 week in-country immersion designated to expand the students' understanding of the impact of cultural differences on health with comparison of differences between the United States and Belize. Involves travel as a group to Belize for study abroad experience for two weeks in May 2020. Completion of UNIV 305 in spring semester prior to study abroad is required. Preparation for the in-country experiences will include monthly meetings via Skype for Business beginning January, 2020.
