


- Chances are, you have given a quiz or two for one of your classes in Moodle.
- But what happens if you accidentally forget to change the point total for a quiz? Are you stuck with 5 points when you meant to allocate 50?
- □ Nope!
- Read on if you want to find out how to make this quick and easy fix.

Step by Step


Step 1: Find the quiz on your course page.
Click the name of the quiz, in this example,

□ Step 2: Click on the "Edit" tab at the top of the screen.




- Step 3: Once on the "Edit" screen, you will see a list of your quiz questions. Each question is assigned an individual point total. Where you see "Maximum Grade" enter the correct point total your quiz should be worth [i.e. 50, 100, etc.]
- Step 4: Click "Save Changes."



Please note that your"Maximum grade" and"Total" should be equal.

If they are NOT, you must go and change the individual points for each question so it adds up to the appropriate total.
