The Program

Real world experience is key when learning how to best work with young children. Mayville State University's early childhood program provides hands-on experience through our Child Development Center and prepares you to make an impact on the lives of young children. This program is also offered online for distance students.

MSU's early childhood program will give you the opportunity to further your professional growth. The program will prepare you to work in a variety of leadership positions, including early childhood administrator, supervisor, curriculum specialist and education coordinator in preschool programs. The program takes full advantage of distance and online learning opportunities to provide flexibility.

Advantages

Hands-on experiences. Mayville State's early childhood program offers you several opportunities to have hands-on experiences with preschool students and teachers. Mayville State's on-campus Child Development Center is a great place for early childhood students to work with young children. They include licensed child care for children six weeks to six years old, Head Start for eligible children ages 3 to 5 years, Early Head Start for children six weeks to three years, and after-school care for local elementary students.

Flexibility. The early childhood program uses technology to provide the kind of flexible experience that meets the needs of both traditional and non-traditional students.











A Word About Our Grads

Mayville State early childhood graduates find many career opportunities open to them. Students can focus on teaching or administration and can choose from a number of specializations. This allows graduates of the program to secure positions in child care, preschool teaching, paraprofessional jobs, Head Start, preschool special needs, after-school programs, family day care, child care resource and referral, infant toddler programs, and administration.

You will complete the general education courses, core requirements for the early childhood major, and then choose one specialization.
