College Studies Certificate

The certificate in College Studies provides documentation of 24 completed credits of Essential Studies (general education) and career exploration work at Mayville State University. The program uses existing course offerings. It will be made available to dual credit students to help them plan their course of study, and it will be offered to students who leave MaSU (at the point of withdrawal/transfer).

College Studies Requirements

All courses within MaSU's Essential Studies program will be eligible toward the certificate program.

Business Studies Certificate

The Business Studies Certificate will provide a student with the general information necessary to start to build a business mindset. Students may want an introduction to the business world or may have pursued another career path and find the need for a basic business background. The Business Studies Certificate program provides an introductory set of skills needed to start in the business world.

The Business Studies Certificate program can be a starting point for furthering a student's business knowledge. Courses will also apply to an associate's or bachelor's degree offered by Mayville State University. This certificate program will provide a completion marker on the transcript for students who transfer or who choose to leave college.

The Business Studies Certificate program can be completed in 9-12 months on-campus or online.

Business Studies Requirements

Students completing the Business Certificate program may be required to complete select Essential Studies coursework based on the elective credits selected.

Special Education Certificate

The Special Education Certificate consists of 9 credits of study in the areas of: learning disabilities, behavior and mental health training, understandings of special education services in schools and communities and the laws and policies that support service to persons with special needs. Students who complete the program may choose to take the national RBT certification exam to become a Registered Behavior Technician. Students may choose to take the program online or a mix of on-campus/online classes.

Conceptual Framework

Our conceptual framework at Mayville State is The Reflective Experiential Teacher. It is based upon a belief that preservice teachers develop abilities to reflect on current research findings, essential and theoretical knowledge, and appropriate teaching strategies and practices through experience. Application requires learning how to reflect, to question, and test hypothesis, while experiential practices engage students in a variety of clinical, field-based opportunities in which to employ and assess their instructional abilities. The theme is based upon established learning concepts that students develop and demonstrate in their coursework, field experiences, and student teaching.

Special Education Requirements

Students completing the Special Education Certificate program may be required to complete select Essential Studies coursework based on the elective credits selected.
