Who is qualified to enroll?

- North Dakota High School Junior or Senior
- Student must have Cumulative GPA of 3.0 (2.5 or higher for SPED 237)

Why is it free?

The Department of Public Instruction (DPI) will pay for each student wanting to take EDUC 250, SPED 237, SPED 289, and/or SPED 289A. The application fee, books, and dual credit tuition will be paid. The State of North Dakota has a teacher shortage, and these dual credit courses are designed to motivate juniors and seniors to consider special education and other teacher education fields.

Class Information

EDUC 250: Introduction to Education is a 16-week online asynchronous 3-credit course for Fall2024 and Spring 2025. The course will be taught by Mayville State faculty member Jeni Peterson and NDCDE faculty member Kaitlyn Allen.

SPED 237: Special needs in ECE is a 16-week online asynchronous 3-credit course for Fall 2024. The course will be taught by Mayville State faculty member Dr. Sarah Kallock.

SPED 289: Foundations of Special Education is a 16-week online asynchronous 3-credit course for Fall 2024 and Spring 2025. The course will be tuaght by Mayville State faculty member Samantha DeLong.

SPED 289A: Foundations of Special Education Field Experience is a 2-credit course with a required 60-hour field experience for Spring 2025. The course is taught by Mayville State faculty member Dr. Carly Theis. This course is available to students who have taken SPED 289 or students who enroll in SPED 289 in Spring 2025.
