#### 1. Biographies (all multi-volumes)

<b>Ref E 176.D563</b>	<i>Dictionary of American Biography</i> (the <i>DAB</i> )	Dead Americans from all fields. Bibliography at end of each article. Set of 10 volumes with 10 supplements. Original 10 volumes alphabetize Americans who died <u>before</u> 1927. To find a person who died <u>after</u> 1927, use index in the very last Supplement. The entire set covers those who died up to 1980. Continued by the set listed below.
<b>REF E 176.D564</b>	<i>American Lives</i>	Starts in 1980, where the <u>DAB</u> stops.
<b>REF CT 213 .A68 1999</b>	<i>American National Biography.</i>	New version of <u>DAB</u> . Bibliography at end of each article. Americans dead before 1999 are in original set. Use the set in the same manner as you use the <u>DAB</u> .
<b>REF CT 214.G74 1987</b>	<i>Great Lives from History: American Series</i>	Bibliography at the end of each biography
<b>REF E174.L90</b>	<i>Harper's Encyclopedia of United States History</i>	In 10 volumes, arranged A-Z
