

Articulation, Credit by Exam and Statewide Agreements

Mayville State University complies with, and utilizes North Dakota University System (NDUS) guidelines, agreements and evaluations to award credits for successful completion of national exams, completion of comparable coursework at other post-secondary institutions, and as a result of system wide agreements with other state systems. These include:

1. Mayville State will award credit for successful completion of College Level Examination Program exams (CLEP), College Entrance Examination Board (CEEB), advanced placement courses in high school (AP); International Baccalaureate (IB) coursework, or DSST examinations as outlined in the NDUS Common Credit-By-Exam Matrix.
2. Mayville State will award credit and grant admission to transfer students who have completed Associate degrees or equivalent coursework at participating institutions in Washington, Minnesota, South Dakota, Wyoming, California, Oregon, and Montana as detailed in NDUS Policies 402.4.1; 402.4.2; 402.4.3; 402.4.4; 402.4.5; 402.4.6; and 402.4.7
3. Mayville State will award credit and grant admission to transfer students who participate in other state and system wide articulation agreements that have been approved by the NDUS Chancellor.
