



# First Destination Outcomes of Mayville State University Graduates



An annual report compiled by Mayville State University Career Services  
 A compilation of the graduating classes of 2013-14, 2014-15 and 2015-16

Career Services staff annually seeks out data about the current 'career status' of our recent graduates. Our data gathering begins during each graduate's final term, but the majority of our surveying and searching is carried out six months after each graduate receives their degree. We determine how (and where) they are employed and/or continuing their education. When graduates agree to share salary data, we also compile that.

Our methodology is to first compile credible contact information ... not always easy to get! We ask faculty and students for information, and of course, do extensive online searches for any potential contact information. We first try to reach graduates by email and ask them to complete a brief online survey available at all times on our website. When emails or other means fail, we turn to calling the graduates. The process is long and time-consuming, but does result in us being able to compile reliable data.
