

Comet Proud Waiver

Mayville State University actively seeks out students who are academically prepared, actively engaged and “Comet Proud” to be a part of the Mayville State campus community. The Comet Proud Waiver seeks to encourage students who join our campus community through active involvement in student organizations, athletics, and other co-curricular programs. To be considered for the Comet Proud Waiver, prospective students must fit into the following criteria:

- New full-time, on-campus student.
- Provide evidence of academic merit through a combination of ACT/SAT scores, GPAs, dual credit, post-secondary, and AP courses, etc.;
 - *Although ACT/SAT scores may not be required for admission to Mayville State University, students should still submit official ACT/SAT scores to the Office of Admissions if they have taken either the ACT or SAT.*
- Have applied and been admitted to Mayville State University for summer or fall terms.
 - Consideration may be given for applicants with unofficial transcripts submitted and official transcripts in process, at the discretion of the Dean of Student Affairs.
- Have submitted the Comet Proud Waiver application form.

Recipients will receive an award as outlined below, with half being applied to their student account fall and spring semester. Awards are non-renewable.

Selection will be determined on a rolling basis at the discretion of a Comet Proud Waiver committee convened by the Dean of Student Affairs, in consultation with the prospective student’s recruiter (Enrollment Center, athletics, music, ODI, etc.) as needed.

A maximum amount and number of waivers will be determined by the President’s Cabinet each year.

Comet Proud awardees are eligible for the following financial awards, in addition to other aid that may be applied to their status as a student. Awards may vary based on available funds and are awarded on a first come, first served basis. Awards cannot be combined with North Dakota/Minnesota Honors or Non-Resident Merit Waivers without prior approval of the Dean of Student Affairs:
