Students who are interested in LRSC's nursing program can complete co-requisite courses at MSU. You will first enroll with MSU and then apply to LRSC's nursing program. If accepted, you will transfer to LRSC to complete the program.

Visit Campus

MSU Pre-Nursing Program

Students pursuing nursing degrees often complete several required academic courses while taking co-requisite courses. This early start allows them to concentrate on nursing skills courses once they are accepted into the nursing program. We encourage this strategy for students who have significant family and work responsibilities. Early start courses include:

- College Composition I
- Microbiology must be done no later than fall semester of AD year
- Introduction to Psychology
- Developmental Psychology
- Algebra prep III or higher must qualify for college Algebra, either by test or classes
- Introduction to Pharmacology
- Anatomy and Physiology I and II
- ENGL 120, ENGL 125 or COMM 110

LRSC Practical Nursing Program

Students may attend Mayville State for co-requisite courses. Apply to Lake Region State College in December of year before joining the Nursing Program. Once accepted, apply to the Dakota Nursing Program. Applications are open from December to March 5th. Classes start in August.

Admission to the LRSC practical nursing program requires:

- Completion of Basic Life Support for Healthcare Providers (CPR), NOT Heartsaver
- Academic and math readiness verified by test scores
- TOEFL required for ESL applicants verified by test scores

Once a student has been accepted into the LRSC nursing program, they will complete the following Lake Region State College nursing courses for the practical nursing program.
