The Program

The program stresses a generalist understanding and application of the nature of business in today's and tomorrow's world of employment. Graduates will be prepared to take higher-level positions or become self-employed, and the program is transfer-friendly, convenient, flexible, and affordable.

The BAS Program is a flexible, transfer-friendly 2+2 program for students who are looking to continue their education after earning an Associate of Arts, Associate of Science or Associate of Applied Science degree (AA, AS, AAS).

The BAS program accepts all credits a student has earned from an accredited college or university.

The BAS program requires no less than 120 credits for graduation. The program is three parts: Essential Studies / 36 credits; Core & Business Concentration / 47 credits; and Electives of at least 37 credits.

Many students will complete the BAS program in two years as a full-time student after successfully earning an AA or AS degree. If a student has earned an AAS degree, there may be additional Essential Studies credits needed to meet the 36-credit requirement for the degree.

The BAS program can be taken on campus or fully online, as a full-time or part-time student. A student can earn a 2-year degree, start in the workforce, and then return to earn the BAS degree later.


