#### TEACHER EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS:

1. # A MINIMUM GRADE OF "C" IS REQUIRED IN COURSE,

- 2. ## A MINIMUM GRADE OF "B" IS REQUIRED IN COURSES,
- 3. A minimum grade point average of 2.75 in the major, minor and professional core courses,
- 4. A minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.75, and
- 5. Must successfully complete and pass the Praxis I and Praxis II tests.
- 6. Students who have not been admitted to Teacher Education will not be permitted to enroll in EDUCATION coursework

at or beyond the 300 level courses with the exception of Early Childhood courses. See Mayville State University's academic catalog for a complete list of all graduation requirements.
