This Bachelor of Science degree provides the foundational coursework necessary for students who are preparing for careers in accounting, finance, auditing, and related fields; or who plan to take professional accounting certification exams. The accounting program has been designed to prepare students for Certified Public Accountant professional licensure exams in North Dakota. North Dakota law requires that individuals who sit for the CPA professional exam complete 150 semester credits of college education. Completion of this program does not award students the CPA designation. On-campus and online/distance students living in or moving to any state other than North Dakota should be aware of the unique CPA licensure requirements for the location in which they intend to live and work.
