PROGRESS UPDATES

- **Basement:** Steel-studded ramp build-out in the theater is underway

- **Fourth floor:** Flooring installation is beginning
- **Exterior:** Bollard installation is wrapping up in the east parking lot near the Campus Center





UPCOMING WORK

Upcoming work includes foaming and installing EPDM (rubber roofing) on the north parapet, hanging light fixtures on the fourth floor, beginning tile installation on the third floor, and installing MCM panels at the east and west mechanical rooms.
