How do I...

UND students taking PHYS 251 – University Physics I online from Mayville State University must register for the course through the collaborative student registration process with the UND Registrat's Office. The information listed above is the course registration information needed to register collaboratively. To register collaboratively for this course, you must be enrolled for Fall 2014 with UND. If you are not planning to register with UND, please contact Jacque Moore at 701.788.4763 to talk about enrolling as a non-degree seeking student with Mayville State University.

Submit a Proctor? *

Proctor information is not shared between campuses so students must submit proctor information to MSU in addition to UND.

- 1. Go to www.mayvillestate.edu
- 2. Click my student portal at the bottom of the page.
- 3. Enter your Username and Password. Your *username* is the same as your login for ConnectND preceded by NDUS\. Your *password* is identical to the password you use for ConnectND and Moodle.
- 4. Click on **Submit Proctor** from the left-hand menu.
- 5. **Proctor Criteria**: In order to be approved as a proctor, a proctor must be a disinterested professional with a valid business office, business telephone, and business email address. Some examples are:
 - a. A superintendent, principal or counselor at a public or private school
 - b. A high school or elementary teacher
 - c. A college or university administrator, dean, department chair, registrar or faculty member
 - d. A professional staff member at a college or university
 - e. A certified librarian
- 6. A proctor must NOT be
 - a. A friend or relative of the student
 - b. Someone enrolled in the course or another student
 - c. Someone living at the same address as the student
- 7. Your proctor must have reliable internet access. Please note you are not allowed to take your exams in your home or your proctor's private home or residence. You must take your exam at a professional office, school, college or university, library, or other business or public institution.

Access my Online Courses from Mapville State University

Mayville State University uses the Learning Management System Moodle for all courses, not Blackboard. You must follow these instructions to access Moodle and your course.

- Go to www.mayvillestate.edu (Firefox should be the browser used to do this. You can download Firefox at www.mozilla.org)
- Click the blue "m" at the bottom of the page.
- 3. Click Login.
- 4. Enter your Username and Password. Your Username is identical to your NDUS User ID which was given to you when you went through the claim process. Your Password will also be identical to what you created in the password creation portion of the claim process.
