INTERNATIONAL EXAM CREDIT

Students can submit official General Certificates of Education (GCE) from University of Cambridge International Examinations for prior learning credit. GCEs should be received within the first semester of enrollment at Mayville State University.

Students can earn credit for Advanced "A" level and Advanced Subsidiary "AS" level examinations only with grades A-E. Elective credit will be granted using an S/U grading scale. Students may work with academic divisions to apply credits to specific MSU general education core. Credit will be awarded for each examination passed as indicated below:

- 8 semester credits will be awarded for Advanced "A" level examinations
- 4 semester credits will be awarded for Advanced Subsidiary "AS" level examinations

A maximum of 30 semester credits total prior learning credit may be awarded.
