Early Entry (Dual Credit) Courses

You can earn college credit in high school while developing advanced critical thinking and communication skills and making the transition to college easier. These are just a few of the benefits of enrolling in a dual credit course. Don't delay. Enroll as an early entry student in a dual credit course.

The Program

Through Mayville State's dual credit program, qualified high school students are able to enroll in specifically approved classes taught at local high schools, through interactive video, or online. Students receive "dual credit," both high school and university credit for the classes. Dual credit gives motivated, college-bound high school students the opportunity to get a "jump start" on college by earning college credit before attending on a full-time basis.

Credit earned under this program will be applicable toward a degree at Mayville State University and other North Dakota University System institutions, and is generally transferable to other accredited colleges and universities.

Who can take Dual Credit courses?

Any high school student enrolled in grades ten, eleven, or twelve who has received permission from his or her school administrator, has a 3.0 GPA, and meets course placement and prerequisite guidelines is eligible for enrollment in a Mayville State designated dual credit course. High school counselors and teachers may advise students regarding their academic readiness and maturity to participate in dual credit courses, and only those students who are academically ready should enroll in a dual credit course.

What will it cost?

Will the classes transfer?

Credits received for dual credit courses appear on your transcript as regular college credit. All dual credit courses can be equally transferred to any college or university within the North Dakota University System. Dual credit courses will generally transfer to other institutions as well; however, it is up to the receiving institution to determine how the credits will be accepted.

• To register, you must complete and submit the Mayville State Application for Admission available online at www.mayvillestate.edu, but only if you have not already done so for a previous term. New applicants will be required to pay a one-time, non-refundable matriculation fee of \$35 by credit card. For step-by-step instructions go to www.mayvillestate.edu and click on "Admissions" and "Early Entry (Dual Credit)". Scroll down to the application tutorial link under "How Do I Register?".

• Then, with the help of your principal and parents, complete the MSU Dual Credit Enrollment Agreement. When completing this form, please be sure to select the correct class section. You will need to have your parents and principal sign this form. Next, have a parent or guardian complete the Parent Agreement Form. Additional forms can be downloaded at www.mayvillestate.edu/dualcredit.

• Finally, have your principal submit the above forms and a copy of your high school transcript to shay.thorsgard@mayvillestate.edu, and arrange to have any needed test results (such as ACT scores for ENGL and MATH placement) sent to Mayville State University.
