This major is designed to provide a flexible, transfer-friendly approach to specifically serve the needs of students who have earned Associate of Arts, Associate of Applied Science or Associate of Science degrees. A previously earned A.A., A.A.S. or A.S. degree will transfer as a block and students will complete a capstone-type program in business administration. Program requirements include 36 hours of essential studies, 32 hours of major core requirements, and 15 hours of supporting business (300/400 level) course work. A total of no less than 120 semester hours is required for graduation. No minor is required.
