TWO ALUMNI "PAY IT FORWARD"

As your foundation director for the past six years, I am amazed and thankful for the increased support of our alumni and friends. This record-setting year of donations was aided in part by two very generous people who benefited Mayville State University by including the foundation in their estate plans.

The first is Leo F. "Bud" Hannon. A class of 1947 education graduate, Leo was a successful teacher and coach and later worked in real estate. One of his crowning achievements was founding the Los Pinos High School for juvenile criminal offenders. Throughout his life, he followed MSU athletics and was a proud member of the MSU Athletic Hall of Fame. It was that love of athletics that led Leo to plan a gift through his estate. His donation of \$10,000 to the Comet Athletic Club will provide scholarships to young athletes to support their education.

The second benefactor who never forgot Mayville State was Ruth Juvet Stone Glaser. Ruth grew up in Mayville, where she excelled in high school, becoming valedictorian in 1935. She then attended MSU, earning her teaching degree in 1939. After her passing in May of 2016, Ruth's family notified MSU that Ruth had left a gift of over \$11,000 to help students at MSU.
