

Follow the instructions below to see how our Distance Student Orientation course converted into Blackboard before being rebuilt:

- 1. <u>Access Blackboard</u> & login using your NDUS credentials
- 2. Click on the **Courses** tab on the top right
- 3. On the left side under **Course Search**, type **Distance Student Orientation** & click **Go.**
- The Course ID is MASU1-DS0 and Alissa Perkins will be listed as the instructor. Click on the arrow that pops up next to the course ID. It looks like this:
- 5. Choose Enroll
- 6. Enter the access code: **comets**
- 7. Choose **Submit.** You are now enrolled and able to explore the course.
