Mayville State University accepts transfer credit from regionally recognized accredited institutions of postsecondary education. All credit hours earned from the institutions that meet this criterion are accepted in transfer toward graduation degree credit hours.

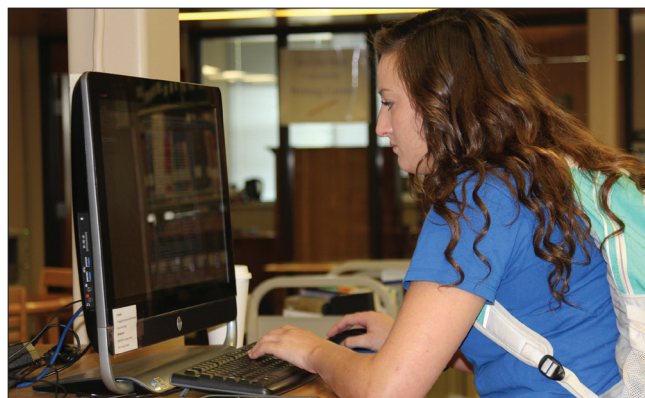
### Flexible

Complete courses as a part-time or full-time student by enrolling for fall, spring, or summer semesters. Admission deadlines are rolling, but early application is encouraged for transfer students to allow sufficient time for transfer evaluations to be completed. Federal financial aid may be available for degree-seeking students enrolled in six or more credits per semester. Mayville State online classes are \$295\* per credit hour for tuition and fees.

Use this checklist as your guide to becoming admitted and successfully enrolling in Mayville State University's online and distance education degree programs. ## 1. Apply for Admission

The first step in becoming a Mayville State distance degree student is applying for admission. You can complete your application for admission online at: [www.mayvillestate.edu](http://www.mayvillestate.edu). Once there, click on "Apply". A \$35 application fee is required.

## 2. Submit Official College Transcripts

You must submit official college transcripts from all schools you have attended. Please have your transcripts mailed to: Admissions Office, Mayville State University, 330 Third Street NE, Mayville, ND 58257.

## 3. Apply for Financial Aid

To apply for federal and state financial aid, you must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and list Mayville State University (Title IV school code 002993) as one of your schools of choice. To receive top priority for grants and loans, submit your FAFSA by February 15 at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov).

## 4. Apply for Scholarships & Waivers

To be considered for any Mayville State scholarship, you must complete and submit the Mayville State scholarship application. This application can be submitted online at [www.mayvillestate.edu](http://www.mayvillestate.edu). The priority date for scholarships and waivers is February 15.
