#### DID YOU KNOW...

Preliminary results suggest that college freshmen's reading ability overall is between 5th and 12th grade. Altogether, findings suggest that two-thirds of college freshman have below proficient reading ability as described by NAEP, or National Assessment of Educational Progress (Olney, Walker, Davis, & Graesser, 2017).

So how do you suppose your emails come across to students? Coworkers? Do you ever worry that you're not understood? Check out the Gunning Fog Index: <a href="http://gunning-fog-index.com/">http://gunning-fog-index.com/</a>. This is a tool that will tell you approximately what grade level you're writing at.

How to use the Gunning Fog Index:

- 1. Write your email.
- 2. Copy and paste it into the Gunning Fog index site.
- 3. Gunning Fog will calculate your score, do a word count, and list your 3+ syllable words so you can make any changes you wish to.
