

2020-21 Season

Due to COVID, our schedule was changed around numerous times but we were finally able to play our first pair of games on November 13th and 14th in the Isreal-Strong memorial classic at Presentation College. In our first game of the 2020-2021 season we pull off the win against Trinity Bible College 75-36 with four players scoring double digits! The second game was against our conference opponent Dickinson State in a non conference game where we won a close one of 70-64! After that weekend Jordan Zrust who is a sophomore for the Comets won NSAA Player of the Week while averaging 20.5 points per game, 4 rebounds, and 2 steals during that weekend. The next set of games would be played at Dakota State in the Dakota Clash Classic. We received our first loss on November 20th against Dakota State 99-55 but ended the weekend on a high note beating another conference opponent Presentation College in a non conference game 59-50. Our final games of the 2020 year pushed our record to 6-1! We played Trinity Bible College for the second time on the 2nd of December and won 77-32. On December 5th we played in our first conference game against Presentation College and won 74-45 bringing our conference record to 1-0. The last game before the new year was played just a day later on the 6th of December against Oaks Hills Christian where we won 81-22! After this weekend, Jordan Zrust received another NSAA player of the week honor with an average of 11.3 points per game, 7.3 rebounds, 1 assist, and 1.3 steals per game. Coach Dennis Hutter said "This is a great start for our team and they all worked very hard to obtain a 6-1 start so far. Playing three different conference opponents in non-conference games also helped so we could see where we are and what we need to work on"
