The Program

Mayville State University is recognized throughout the region for preparing quality teachers. This B.S.Ed. in Physical Education program is available online and will prepare you for a career in teaching. Upon successful completion of the program, you will be eligible to seek K-12 teacher certification.

- 1. The program includes field experiences designed for teaching K-12 certification. These experiences are completed at approved schools and other educational institutions in your community or area.
- 2. Students work closely with their advisor throughout the program to best plan semester coursework. Summer coursework will be required for online/distance education students.
- 3. Online/distance education students will be required to attend in-school ield experiences and complete a semester-long student teaching experience at the end of the program.

- 5. Mayville State University's nationally accredited education programs have been designed to meet the licensure/ certification requirements in North Dakota and prepare students for licensure exams in North Dakota. Students living in or moving to any state other than North Dakota should be aware of the unique requirements for that state. Students seeking to establish licensure outside the state of ND must meet with an academic advisor before beginning any online/distance program that would lead to licensure. All students need to understand the licensure requirements in the state they intend to seek teacher licensure. Students are required to notify their assigned academic advisor if the intended location of licensure changes. MSU does not currently accept online education students from Kentucky and New York.

Essential Studies Courses

Physical Education majors must complete 36 hours of Essential Studies. The following Essential Studies courses require a minimum grade of "C": COMM 110, ENGL 110, ENGL 120 or ENGL 125, GEOG 103, MATH 103 or MATH 104, and PSYC 111. Additional requirements to the major include: BIOL 111, BIOL 111L or BIOL 150, BIOL 150L, BIOL 220, BIOL 220L, HPER 100 and HPER 210. These courses are pre-requisite courses to this major.
