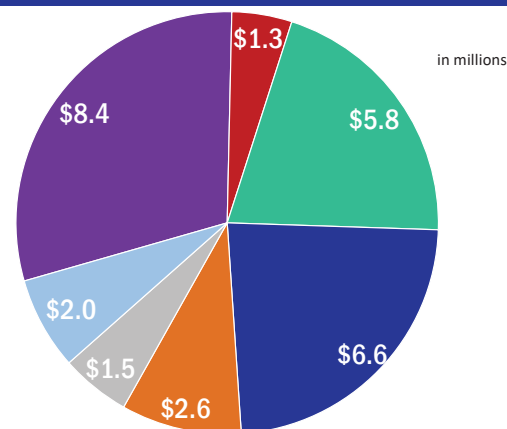

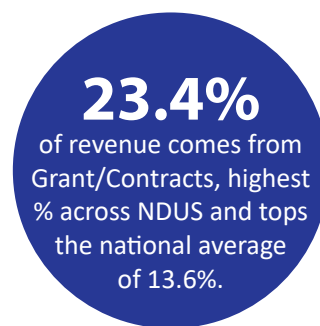
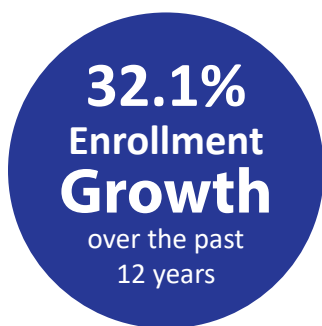
Mayville State appeals to a population of North Dakota residents who prefer the family atmosphere and personal attention offered by faculty and staff on our small college campus.

Affordability

Each student at Mayville State receives an education that is affordable and is enhanced by Mayville State's legendary personal service that helps ensure student success.

Innovation

Responding to workforce needs, Mayville State has developed an innovative Master of Education degree to accommodate needs for teaching professionals in P12 with advanced education. Degree completion can be achieved in as little as one year.

Responsiveness

Catering to an evolving health care environment, Mayville State has developed accelerated programs so that practicing nurses may continue to work while pursuing their baccalaureate and master's degrees. 73% of our nursing program students are from North Dakota and are working full-time.

162% increase in MSU Foundation assets over past ten years to \$13.3M strengthens financial base to provide scholarship opportunities to students.
