Technology Planning Committee

Purpose:

The Technology Planning Committee (TPC) provides leadership for the development and integration of campus technology that will promote the improvement of: instruction, communication, and academic & administrative support. The TPC serves as an advisory committee to the CIO in regard to the MSU Technology Plan, equipment standards and acquisition, the MSU Web Site, and other technology issues. The CIO or designee will serve as chair of the TPC.

Membership:

The Technology Planning Committee has sixteen members with faculty, staff, and student representation. The committee has the following representatives: five faculty members (one representative from each division), seven staff/faculty members (one representative from the each of the following: Byrnes-Quanbeck Library, Information Technology Services, Extended Learning, Online Learning Committee, Finance/Business Office, Enrollment Services and Student Affairs), two students (selected by the student senate) and the CIO. The Vice President for Academic Affairs is an ex-officio member. Information Technology Services personnel and other MSU faculty/staff may serve as committee resource personnel and are non-voting members. Committee members have a one year renewable term.

Meetings:

The Technology Planning Committee meets a minimum of twice per year to discuss the technology needs of the campus.
