The Graduate Studies: Academic Standards Subcommittee is a committee within the Admissions and Academic Standards Committee to address these standards at the graduate level.

Membership: The Subcommittee will consist of three to five graduate faculty representatives appointed by the Dean and Division Chair of Education. The appointed faculty members shall serve one-year, renewable terms beginning in the fall semester. The Dean will serve as an ex-officio and nonvoting member of the committee. A chair of the committee will be elected by the members for the purposes of coordination and reporting.

Purpose: The Graduate Studies: Academic Standards Subcommittee monitors and recommends policy to the Faculty Senate in the areas of graduate admissions and academic standards.

The committee monitors student progress in meeting the graduate academic standards of the University. Responsibilities include developing standards for graduate academic probation and retention, rendering decisions involving academic suspensions, appeals from academic suspensions, and setting conditions of readmission for students successfully appealing an academic suspension.

Meetings and/or Appeals: The committee shall meet as needed. The chair of the committee will preside over the hearing. The decisions and recommendations of the appeals committee shall be by majority vote and will be advisory to the Dean and Division Chair of Education and presented to the VPAA, who will be responsible for taking appropriate action(s).
