The Teaching and Learning Committee

Purpose:

The Teaching and Learning Committee (TLC) strives to improve student success through the implementation and practice of instructional technology in Mayville State University courses. Areas of focus include, but are not limited to, policy and procedures that support course quality, student authentication and integrity, course design, existing and emerging instructional technology, creative pedagogy, accessibility, and faculty training and development.

Membership:

The Teaching and Learning Committee consists of 10 voting members: Instructional Designer, Academic Technology Specialist, the Director of Center for Teaching and Learning, and the Director of Enrollment Center have permanent membership. Appointed members include a faculty representative from each academic division serving two- year appointments with (Science/Math, Nursing, Business appointed in even years; Education, Liberal Arts, and HPER appointed in odd years). An online student member will be appointed by the MSU Student Senate to serve a minimum of a one-year appointment. The TLC Chair is appointed by the voting committee membership.

Meetings:

The Teaching and Learning Committee shall meet at least four times per semester and may include summer. If a committee member is unable to attend, an alternate should be provided.

Terms:

Faculty 2-year appointment; student 1-year appointment.
